



To empower young men to pursue excellence, contribute to an ever-changing world, and live a life of faith, zeal and purpose.




Student Body





Partnership with Dual Credit Universities



Through partnerships with four universities, students have an opportunity to earn college credit while at Saint Patrick. Beginning sophomore year, students can enroll in select classes taught by teachers with a Masters Degree in the subject area or a university professor.

The average student enrolled in Dual Credit courses at Saint Patrick saves \$24,000 in college tuition.

Partnership with Shedd Aquarium

In 2019, Saint Patrick became the first high school, and only the second high school in Chicago, to partner with the Shedd Aquarium. The Shedd Academy program, meant to engage students in the field of Aquatic Science throughout their four years of high school, offers field trips for freshman, career panels during sophomore year, and coursework and internship opportunities for juniors and seniors.

Business INCubator Program

The Business INCubator program at Saint Patrick offers students an authentic entrepreneurship experience. Students in the program have the opportunity to create and fully develop their own product or service with the help of more than 25 Alumni and friends of Saint Patrick who serve as mentors and coaches.

STEAM Internships

Students in the STEAM program have an opportunity to work with an alumnus or friend of Saint Patrick at an internship in their desired career field or interest. The internship program allows students to explore potential career paths and develop new technical and interpersonal skills in a professional environment.

Financial Support.

Due to the generosity of our alumni and benefactors, Saint Patrick is able to offer families from across the Chicagoland area \$1.5 million in tuition assistance and scholarships yearly.

» To be eligible for academic scholarships students must test at Saint Patrick on December 4, 2021. (Individual circumstances may cause an exception)

Merit Awards

International Lasallian Award for Academic Excellence

» All students testing between the 95th-99th percentile will receive the amount of \$22,000 (\$5,500 annually).

Saint Patrick Academic Achievement Award

» All students testing between the 90th-94th percentile will receive the amount of \$14,000 (\$3,500 annually).

Saint Patrick Academic Merit Award

» All students testing between the 76th-89th percentile will receive the amount of \$10,000 (\$2,500 annually).





Scholarships



First Responders Scholarship

» Students who are the sons of police officers, firefighters or paramedics are eligible to receive the Fr. Thomas A. Mulcrone First Responders Scholarship in the amount of \$8,000 (\$2,000 annually).



Catholic Identity Scholarship

» Students who are the sons of Catholic school or parish employees are eligible to receive the Catholic Identity Scholarship in the amount of \$8,000 (\$2,000 annually).



Legacy Scholarship

- » The Legacy Scholarship is available to sons or grandsons of Saint Patrick alumni in the amount of \$10,000 (\$2,500 annually).
- » If a student qualifies for multiple scholarships and or financial assistance grants, only the one with the highest dollar amount will be honored. All scholarships have annual renewal guidelines.

Tuition Assistance


