Re: Summer School Credit Recovery

The credit recovery function of summer school, resolving failures incurred during the year, is now facilitated online.

Educere, the provider for Founders Education, accredited by AdvancED, the State of Illinois, and the Chicago Archdiocese and the Office of Catholic Schools, will again facilitate the program to resolve failures (other than our Religion courses) incurred during the school year. A number of our students have earned online credit last summer; they found the experience to be flexible and responsive to their schedules and needs. All course work is to be completed in 8 weeks (Th., 2 Aug 18). There is NO flexibility in this deadline. Math, English, Science, and Social Studies teachers will be available to serve as a resource for our students. Students will report to school weekly from 10:00 to noon on the day the respective subject course teacher is available. (Days to be determined.)

Saint Patrick High School will facilitate the summer program for any Religion deficiency. The program follows the USCCB curriculum. These classes will be conducted in a hybrid online format. Students will need to register at Saint Patrick High School between M., 4 June or W., 6 June 2018, from 9:00 until noon. Students may need to report to school for 3 or 4 sessions, determined by Mr. Eberle. The summer Religion program is open to all Catholic school students. Tuition per half credit for Shamrocks is \$300 and \$400 for non-Saint Patrick High School students
